

Implementation Guidelines for Graduation Projects in the International Honors Bachelor's Degree Program, College of Business, Kainan University

Passed by the 5th Program Meeting of the 2024 Academic Year on March 19, 2025

Passed by the 5th College Affairs Meeting of the 2024 Academic Year on April 17, 2025

Article 1

The International Honors Bachelor's Degree Program of the College of Business, Kainan University (hereinafter referred to as "the Program") has established these guidelines to assist undergraduate students in participating in graduation projects, enabling them to comprehensively apply their acquired knowledge and develop practical problem-solving abilities.

Article 2

The Program establishes the following implementation rules:

1. Students shall select a supervising professor based on their interests and the professor's expertise, with full-time faculty members of the Program being the primary choice for supervising professors. If students wish to be supervised by professors from other departments or by adjunct professors, approval from the Program Director is required.
2. Each project group shall consist of three to five students in principle; any group with a different number of members requires approval from the Program Director.
3. A supervising professor may supervise up to six project groups; supervision of more than six groups requires approval from the Program Director.

Article 3

The content of the graduation project shall be developed with the assistance of the supervising professor, who shall provide the topic and a brief introduction to the Program Curriculum Committee for review.

Article 4

For matters not covered by these guidelines, implementation may proceed with the approval of the supervising professor and the Program Director.

Article 5

These guidelines shall be implemented after being passed by the Program Meeting and reviewed by the College Affairs Meeting; the same applies to amendments.
